

A New Security Grant for Canadian Organizations

The Canada Community Security Program (CCSP) helps organizations protect at-risk communities by covering up to 70% of project costs for physical security upgrades like cameras, lighting, alarms, and access control.

What is the Canada Community Security Program (CCSP)?

Community Protection

The CCSP offers grants for physical security projects, and is designed to improve the safety of people at risk of hate crimes.

Complete Coverage

The new grant can be used for a wide range of upgrades like cameras, alarms, locks, lighting, reinforced doors, and more.

SIP Replacement

The CCSP replaced the Security Infrastructure Program (SIP) in October 2024 to add broader availability & faster processing.

Federal Funding

CCSP grants are available nationwide, and provide funding up to \$100k, backed by Public Safety Canada.

What Does It Take to Qualify?

Your organization may qualify for CCSP funding if it meets these criteria:

Incorporated in Canada

Is a legally incorporated organization under federal or provincial law, actively operating within Canada as a non-profit, charitable, or community-based entity.

Provides qualifying services

Operates public services for at-risk populations, like places of worship, religious or cultural community centers, schools, daycares, cemeteries, and community offices.

Serves an at-risk community

Provides services or facilities for people who are vulnerable to hate-based threats, discrimination, or violence due to race, religion, ethnicity, sexual orientation, or cultural identity.

Can demonstrate credible risk

Evidence of past incidents or a reasonable expectation of risk, such as police reports, documented threats, vandalism, or relevant community context that requires enhanced protection.

How to Apply



Step 1 - Get Prepared

- Conduct a thorough, site-wide risk or threat assessment.
- Gather detailed contractor quotes, budget, and floor plans.
- Obtain your organization's incorporation documents.



Step 2 – Apply Online

- Visit the <u>CCSP Application Portal</u> on the PSC website.
- Carefully read and follow the steps to submit your application.
- After applying, await review, approval, and reimbursement.
